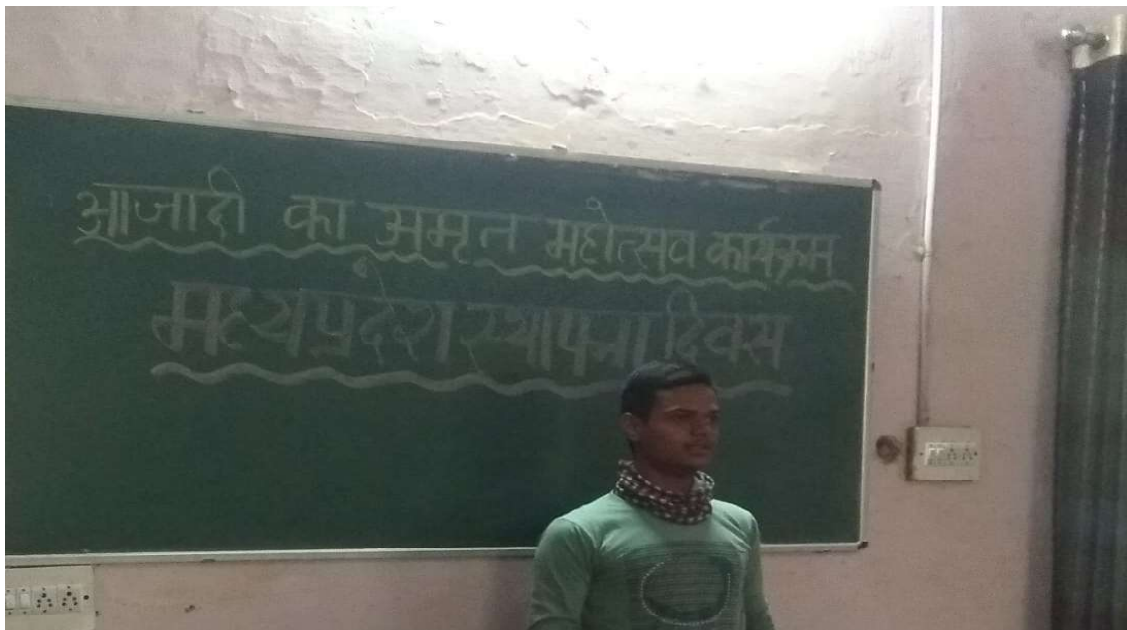
13. WORLD FOREST DAY 2022

Practice of 'Surya Namaskar' offers a number of health benefits. It improves blood circulation and body posture with the creation of a strong and flexible spine.

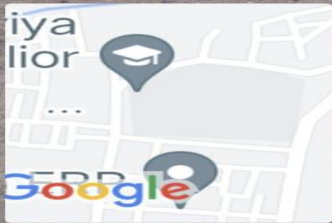
